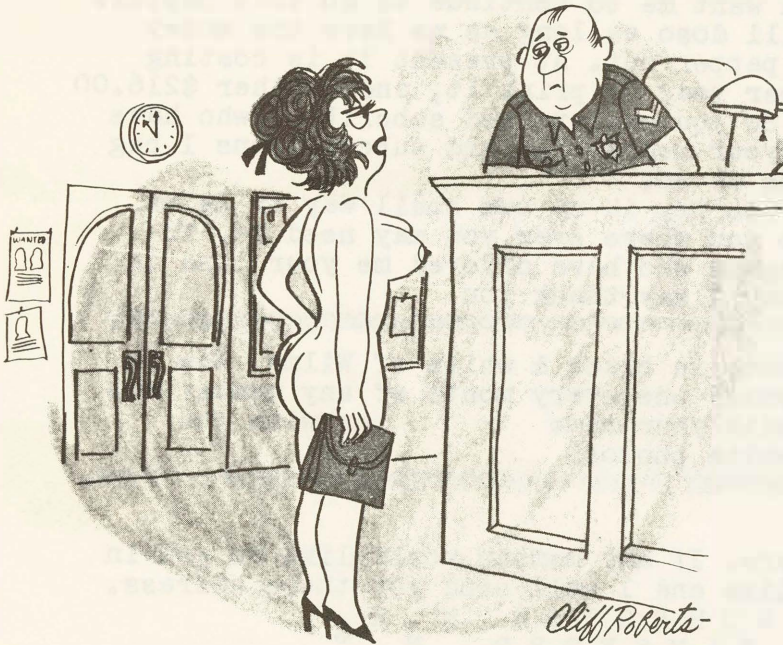


ANSWERS TO QUESTION OF THE MONTH
