

Masquerade As Woman.

Boston, June 26.—An autopsy performed on the charred remains of Harriet Kelly, stewardess, who was one of the two women burned to death in the fire that destroyed the excursion steamer Governor Andrew last Sunday morning disclosed the fact that Harriet was a man. This fact became public today for the first time.

For thirty years Harriet has lived as a woman and was known on the Governor Andrew as a widow. No reason for his masquerade is known. For several years he was employed as a domestic in aristocratic backbay families, and always gave satisfaction.
