

Suspect arrested, faces extradition

MANCHESTER, N.H. — A Massachusetts man is being returned to his home state for questioning about a killing. George A. Stallings, 25, of Boston waived extradition Monday at a hearing in Manchester District Court. Police say they arrested Stallings Sunday while he was driving a Cadillac stolen from the dead man, Rufus Thomas. He was charged with possession of stolen property and falsely identifying himself as Thomas. Thomas' body was discovered last week in his Boston-area apartment. (AP)
