Sept 20, 1962 Bennie Toney comes To Uplift
To tell what he saw. Randy is away
in Baltimore. He leaves his name &
address.

weds

Sept 23, 1962 - Randy gets message that witness
is "shy" & doesn't want to go to police
or Anti-Violence Project on his own.

Fri

Sept 25, 1962 - Those who talked to Toney reveal
he expressed willingness to go with cops
in window darkened car & point on the
4 suspects for them. -

Fri 9/25 2:30 pm - Wicker call Det Abrieu gives the
witness name & address, ^{Room number & name "Toni"} Abrieu says, "I
should go right up there and talk to this
guy."

Fri 9/25 3:55 pm - Det. Abrieu calls back to say he
didn't find any hotel at address given,
██████████ ST, reads name & address back
& describes park and movie theater across
street. Wicker, ^{now} believing the "witness"
is not valid decides to do full search
of ██████████ ██████████ ST to find hotel with
similar name.

Sat. 9/26 Bill Dobbs comes in + says Hotel
██████████ is at ██████████ ST - We call
Hotel & they give us ██████████
phone # - Address is ██████████ ST.
██████████ confirms that
Bennie Toney lives in Room ██████████. We
leave message

Sun. 9/27 - Toney comes in to Uplift. Accompanied
by Wicker, he goes to 6th Pet at
4:05 pm + gives deposition to Det.
"Marjello" (check spelling) - pronounced
"more jello"

Mon 9/28 - Toney receives death threat on phone.
Believes police are showing his photo around
to people who will do him in. Saying
"I don't trust the police," Toney is taken to
Anti-Violence Project where Bra Hanson
says they will be his counsel with the
P.D. Later, they go to river and
make a video-tape. Toney wants to do
this so that if he dies, at least this
testimony will be left behind.

Toney doesn't mind name + picture
appearing but wants address kept secret.

- Sat. Oct 3rd - Furious over the 6th Pet inaction, Wicher writes 4-page letter to Commander Kennedy & leaves it under ~~the~~ windshield wipers of personal cars owned by officers - & leaves videotape for Commander Kennedy, who is due in on Tuesday, Oct 6th.
- Mon. Oct 5th - Abureu calls Wicher, says he "made a mistake" and says - "You should have talked to me before you went crazy." Claims he had [REDACTED] St." as address.
- Wed Oct 7th - Wicher calls Pet, goes over after he disconnects to see if Kennedy had received letter & videotape - was told he HAD NOT received it.
- Thurs Oct 8 - Wicher delivers Second videotape for Commander Kennedy. Gets brief audience with Kennedy who promises to watch the Tape & give to Sgt Fahy, the officer now in charge of detectives - including Abureu.
- Wed Oct 14th - Villager reports story quoting Fahy as saying " - see Article" -
