My goals for a social organization are stated in my written statement. The organizational structure for such an organization are roughly blueprinted in my proposed constitution for the Cherrystone Social Club. To achieve these goals I recognize the path to be through trusted and dedicated leadership, patience, and personal financial stability. Although I am dedicated and patient and willing to provide the leadership, I lack personal financial stability. That for now has immediate priority.

My battle plan is this: 1.) Find an acceptable job, possibly with career potential.

2.) While becoming stable in the job, sponsor social gatherings using my residence in North Hampton as a base. These meetings would be in the form of monthly parties. Also, because of the specially cordial atmosphere at my residence, smaller, less formal meetings can be arranged.

3.) Through these gatherings and through communications a core membership can be built. This membership would be built with an eye on the future, and a heavy emphasis on friendship and proper attitude.

4.) The search for adequate facilities can then begin. These facilities would be located in an urban area such as Brookline or Newton. If an apartment, the size would be at least three bedrooms, living room and kitchen. The cost of such a facility in the location mentioned, including phone and utilities, would range between \$375.00 and \$450.00 monthly. This cost would be shared by the resident, the Outreach Foundation, and the membership. If a house with five bedrooms, the cost (using the same criterion as for the apartment) would range between \$600.00 and \$750.00 depending on the quality of the facility.

Adequate facilities can be realistically located by September.

It is my intention to be the resident, and to act as executive secretary until this organization is stable enough to function under the guidelines already outlined in the proposed constitution, and in my previous statement.
